COMPETITION RULES 2018

Schools Quality Mark Competition Rules (SUMMARY) 2018

- All teams shall be under the direct and sole control of a teacher. A school team must be accompanied by a teacher of that school.
- Where two teams play in similar colours the away team must change. Goalkeepers must wear a distinctive colour.
- 3. All matches shall be played under the Laws of the Game with the following exceptions:-
 - (a) There shall be no strict application of the law as to the dimensions of the ground, but subject to the prior agreement of both teachers.
 - (b) In all ties a maximum of five substitutes may be used chosen from a maximum of five named players. The names of the substitutes must be given to the referee prior to the commencement of the match. Substitutes not so named may not take part in the match.
 - (c) The duration of each match shall be:-

School Quality Mark Cup U13 - 30 minutes each way

All final matches when drawn will have periods of extra time as follows:-School Quality Mark Cup U13 - 5 minutes each way The tie will be settled on penalties.

School Quality Mark Cup U15 - 35 minutes each way

All final matches when drawn will have periods of extra time as follows:-School Quality Mark Cup U15 - 10 minutes each way The tie will be settled on penalties.

School Quality Mark Cup U17 - 40 minutes each way

All final matches when drawn will have periods of extra time as follows:-School Quality Mark Cup U17 - 10 minutes each way The tie will be settled on penalties.

- All ties shall be played on a grass or 3G astroturf surface except with the prior agreement of both teachers.
- 5. The result of each match is to be notified by the winning team, or both teams in a drawn game to the Organiser within ONE day of the date specified for that round.
- 6. A player dismissed from the field of play shall be automatically suspended from the next match in the Northern Ireland Minor Cup. The teacher in charge of the team should notify the Organiser of the player dismissed.
- 7. A team which has 3 or more players sent off in a match refereed by an officially appointed referee shall be eliminated from that competition.
- 8. All teams should complete a short match report and send through to the tournament organiser.
