Behaviour at the National Football Stadium at Windsor Park



The Irish FA has the right in the case of any serious or persistent breach of these provisions to cancel and/or withdraw any ticket or Campaign Card issued to you. In the event of such cancellation and/or withdrawal no refund will be paid.

Getting there

Please check the map to see which entrance you need to use as this may have changed.

Fans entering via Boucher Road can park at Apollo Road via Stockman's Lane. Fans entering via Donegall Avenue can park in the Lower Windsor area. All fans should be mindful of our neighbours within the area of the Stadium. Vehicle movement will be restricted post-event until all fans are clear of the area.
