BEHAVIOUR AT THE NATIONAL FOOTBALL STADIUM AT WINDSOR PARK

All ticket holders must ensure they are not in breach of the football provisions of the Justice Act (NI) in regards to Section 36 (throwing of articles capable of causing injury), Section 37 (chanting of a sectarian, indecent or racial nature), Section 38 (going on to the playing area) and Section 39 (possession of fireworks, flares etc). Please keep stairwells & walkways clear at all times.

The Irish FA has the right in the case of any serious or persistent breach of these provisions to cancel and/or withdraw any ticket or Campaign Card issued to you. *In the event of such cancellation and/or withdrawal no refund will be paid.*


