



INVER PARK ADMISSION POLICY

Everyone is welcome at Inver Park Football Ground regardless of class, creed or race, provided they are prepared to observe the ground regulations and follow the Code of Conduct for Spectators. Management reserves the right to refuse admission to any person who fails to comply with these Rules.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Spectators should refrain from:

- Wearing facial coverings/ balaclavas
- Using foul, abusive or insulting language or gestures
- Using sectarian or racist language, or singing sectarian, racist or abusive songs or chants
- Being drunk or disorderly, or using threatening behaviour
- Using pyrotechnics (smoke bombs, flares)

Spectators should:

- Follow all directions from stewards or other authorised personnel
- Show respect to other supporters, all the players and the match officials by their actions and words and help everyone to enjoy the game
- Observe this Code of Conduct and the Ground Regulations

GROUND REGULATIONS

1. All persons entering Inver Park Football Ground must pay the correct charge for admission or hold a valid admission ticket. No refunds will be given in any circumstances.
2. Knives, darts, fireworks, smoke bombs, glass bottles, glasses, flags, poles, whistles or any other article likely to cause injury or offence are prohibited from the Ground.
3. Spectators may be searched on entry to the Ground or within the Ground if deemed necessary, to ensure that prohibited articles are or have not been brought into the Ground.
4. The club reserve the right to refuse admission or remove any person from the Ground who refuses to be searched by a Steward, Police Officer or any authorised person.
5. Persons intoxicated through alcohol or other substances, or acting in a disorderly or provocative manner may be refused admission to the Ground.
6. Throwing missiles, invading the play area, threatening or violent behaviour, or other behaviour likely to provoke a breach of the peace are prohibited.
7. Obstruction of gangways, access ways, entrances, exits and stairways, or climbing on fences, walls, barriers, buildings or structures and standing on seats or otherwise misusing any of the facilities provided are strictly prohibited.
8. Spectators must comply with all directions given by Stewards or Police Officers. Transfer from one part of the Ground to another is not permitted unless with the approval of a Police Officer or Club Official.
9. No dogs or animals are permitted into the Grounds (except registered assistance dogs).
10. Any infringement of these Regulations may lead to removal from the Ground or being refused future admission to the Ground or, for more serious offences, arrest by the Police.
